The **[ceal Color** Art Auction is an opportunity for local fine artists to participate in a juried "50/50" event on November 16 at Midway Village. Proceeds from all works sold benefit both Temple Beth-El and the artist, each receiving 50% of the sale price. Artists set their own minimum price for each work. Artists are invited to attend the event and are welcome to invite family and friends. This event is open to the general public.

Submissions: Artists may submit up to four (4) pieces of work to be auctioned, each subject to jury consideration. Media is limited to fine art and fine craft only. 3D art is limited in size to no larger than 3 cubic feet (3' x 3'x 3'). Jury criteria will include creativity/originality, composition/design, mastery of technique, and overall visual impression. Applications are due no later than Friday, October 18. Artists will be notified of jury selection by Wednesday, October 30.

Applications must be accompanied by a maximum of four (4) high-quality, high-resolution images and a brief artist biography. All applications must be filled out completely to be considered. File formats include jpeg, tiff, or pdf. Name each image with last name and number corresponding to the title and description on this application (e.g., berney 1.jpg). Email all applications and images to Barbara Berney at berneydesign@gmail.com.
